Also present were Chris Wilson, City Administrator, Mark Sorrell, City Attorney, Glenda Smallwood, City Clerk, Whitney Choat, City Planner, and Bradley Wallace, Director of Operations. Approximately fifteen (15) other people were present.

Chairman Cady called the meeting to order. Alderman Jim Loftis opened the meeting with prayer. Following the Pledge of Allegiance led by Bradley Wallace, a motion was made by Alderman Jobes to approve the minutes of the regular meeting of January 2, 2008 with any corrections, deletions, or additions necessary. Motion seconded by Alderman Stark. Motion passed unanimously with Alderman Guy being absent. Alderman Huling abstained.

# **PLANNING**

The Planning Agenda was presented to the Board by Whitney Choat, City Planner.

Item #1. Amendments to the Development Guideline Manual Section 13-6(b);Sec.13-6(e); and Sec. 13-6(i).

Ms. Choat reported these are amendments to our sign regulations. She reported we have had situations where people want to utilize their signage of the front of their buildings for what they are selling and not for the name of the company. The first amendment allows for the name on the sign to agree with the business license.

She reported on the double faced V regular and political signs. They are not allowed.

No political signs on utility pole, traffic signs, street name signs, fences, sidewalks, subdivision entrance areas, schools or parks.

She reported that feather banner, or flutter flags also known as dancing men have been prohibited. Signs attached to the bed of a truck or trailer be prohibited. If the work on the signage has not been done in six months or varies from what has been approved either at this board level or through sign permitting in the office; the permits can be revoked. They will have to reapply and come in front of this board and explain why they did not go verbatim with what they submitted. The fines will be added at that point.

A motion was made by Alderman Jobes to approve item #1 as presented. Motion seconded by Alderman Loftis. Motion passed unanimously with Alderman Guy being absent.

Item #2 Application by Kim Kreunen for subdivision approval for Lakes of Nicholas Sec. J on the north side of Star Landing, west of Getwell Road. She reported it encompasses 8.39 acres of property. She reported it does allow for R-8, 8000 sq ft lots. This is part of the original PUD. It also allows for minimum heated sq footage of 1600 sq ft on the houses. It also encompasses a 6.47 acre common open space to be associated with this phase of the subdivision. We have requested they put the general note on the plats and the maintenance will be maintained by the property owner's association. It is in complete compliance. A motion was made by Alderman Huling to approve item #2 as presented and approved by the Planning Commission. Motion passed unanimously with Alderman Guy being absent.
