

# Snowden Grove Soccer Complex

## General Rules:

1. **No Climbing on Goals!!! Safety of your child and other children around the Goal is #1 concern.**
2. No Pets allowed
3. No Alcohol
4. No Tobacco, Smoking, or Vaping (Only permitted outside of complex, this includes parking area)
5. No Skates, In-line skates, skateboards, or scooters
6. No Sidewalk chalk
7. No artificial noisemakers.
8. DCSA Soccer participants must use designated Snowden parking lots.
9. **If a ball goes into the pond, Do Not retrieve it yourself. Please inform a staff member and we will attempt to retrieve your ball.**
10. Lost and found items should be turned in to concession stand employee.

## Coaches, Parents and Players:

1. Bench Area (midfield to corner flag) – Designated for Coach, Assistant Coach, Manager and Players. NO MORE than three designated Adults in the Bench Area at one time.
2. Spectator Area (midfield to corner flag) – Opposite field side of Bench Area. Designated for ALL spectators.
3. No coaching/sitting/standing behind the goals.
4. Any player wearing jewelry (any type of jewelry) will not be permitted to participate in games until jewelry has been removed. NO EXCEPTIONS!!

## Weather Policy:

Our intention will be to get ALL games played on the scheduled days/times.

Safety is our number one concern for coaches, players, and spectators. Game cancellations and complex closures are made at the time of the most current weather information using Hourly Forecast, Radar, and mobile apps to make the most informed decision possible. **Coaches will be emailed when cancellation decisions are made OR you may check the Southaven Parks and Recreation Hotline at 901-244-2010 OR by checking for updates on Twitter at @SnowdenGroveSOC**

1. One long horn blast/whistle indicates approaching inclement weather and games are delayed. Coaches, players, and parents need to vacate the field and seek shelter in your vehicle.
2. Three short horn blasts/whistles indicates weather has passed and it is safe to begin play again. Games will start back in 10 minutes.
3. While under a delay – No one is permitted to be on the fields. Continue to seek shelter.
4. Any game cancelled after halftime will stand as the score indicates and be considered game completed.
5. Any game cancelled before halftime will be made up at a later date.
