Citizen's Police Academy

Chief Macon Moore of the Southaven Police Department announces that our 18th annual Citizen's Police Academy (CPA) will begin Monday, March 07, 2022. The CPA will be a ten-week course and will be taught on Mondays and run until May 9, 2022. The majority of the classes will be held at the Southaven Police Department's West Precinct, located at 7320 Highway 51 Southaven, Mississippi; with the exception of a few. The main objective of the CPA is to give citizens an insight into how the SPD serves their community. All classes will begin at 6:30pm and will be taught by members of the SPD or law enforcement officers in the surrounding area. Topics of instruction will include Patrol Operations, Communications, Investigations, K-9, SWAT, Traffic, Hostage Negotiations, Search and Rescue, Driving Course, and Narcotics.

The CPA is open to any resident of Desoto County. You must be a minimum of 21 years of age to participate. To apply, pick up an application at the Southaven Police Department on Northwest Drive or visit Southaven.org.

All applications must be turned in by February 21, 2022.

The class size is limited to 25 participants.
